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Adult Summer Reading Program May 23-July 22

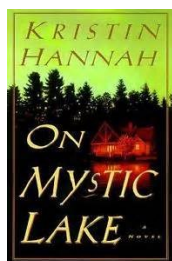
The first 25 to sign up get a free cloth tote bag!
